Dear Customer,

This correspondence is in relation to the recent Log4j2 vulnerability in an open-source logging library that is commonly used by software applications and services.

We can confirm that no software developed by Campbell Scientific uses Log4j2, and none of our software dependencies use Log4j2. Our cloud data services are hosted in either Amazon AWS or Microsoft Azure data centers (product dependent).
